HUMAN RESOURCES UPDATE

Health Insurance Open Enrollment

Open Enrollment for Health Insurance was a huge success and I think many employees are pleased with the plans offered by MAMSI and DentaQuest. The new plan year for both medical and dental coverage began October 1, 2006. By now, everyone should have received medical and dental insurance cards, however, if not, please contact the HR Department.

Flexible Spending Accounts (FSA)

Once again, it's time to think about FSA for calendar year 2007. All current participants who would like to continue into 2007 will need to re-enroll, as elections made in 2006 will not carry over into 2007. Employees who are not currently participating, and meet the eligibility requirements, may enroll during Open Enrollment. Additional information and Enrollment Forms will be distributed early in November.

401(k) Plan

We all have retirement dreams that include financial security. But a secure retirement future doesn't just happen. It takes vision, planning and determination. In 2007, employees will be able to set aside up to \$15,500 in the company-sponsored 401(k) plan, an increase of \$500 from 2006. Also in 2007, employees age 50 and over can add an additional \$5,000, for a total of 20,500 in contributions to your 401(k) account. Remember, your 401(k) savings are tax deferred. Neither your contributions nor your investment earnings are taxed until you begin to withdraw money, usually at retirement.

Some employees received a return on a portion of their 2006 401(k) deferrals due to the Annual Non-Discrimination Testing results. This situation is usually caused by an imbalance in workforce participation in the plan. We will attempt to avoid refunds in the 2007 deferrals by requesting a mid-year preliminary test with projected figures. This information will be forwarded to those impacted so deferral adjustments can be made, if necessary, prior to the end of the calendar year.

James George Completes the 31st Annual Marine Corps Marathon

AMDEX's own James George, a Senior Systems Analyst at CBP, ran his first marathon in the 31st Annual Marine Corps Marathon on October 29th. With only 26 weeks until the starting gun, James endured rigorous training with his daughter, Tara.

With a high level of energy and anticipation, the race started near the U.S. Marine Corps War Memorial (Iwo Jima) just outside Rosslyn. The event drew 120,000 people, which included 34,000 runners. The Marine Corps Band and various school bands played. The event was divided into three groups, separated at 15-minute intervals. James and Tara ran in the final group of approximately 19,000 runners.

As James neared the finish line, he recalls his intense emotions at the sight of the Iwo Jima Memorial. It was a very moving moment as he passed the finish line, his name was called out, and a young Marine placed the finisher medal around his neck. Hearing the loud cheers of his family, James realized that the effort, pain and preparation had been well worth it. James finished at the 20,850th position, after approximately 7 hours of controlled effort. The completion of this race was an amazing achievement, considering his age of 63 years, diabetes, and other assorted ailments. Congratulations on an excellent accomplishment.
